

The University of Maryland Graduate School Receives Insight Into Diversity 2024 Higher Education Excellence In Diversity (HEED) Award

Today, the University of Maryland Graduate School received the 2024 Higher Education Excellence in Diversity (HEED) Award from Insight Into Diversity magazine, the oldest and largest diversity-focused publication in higher education. As a recipient of the annual HEED Award — a national honor recognizing U.S. colleges and universities that demonstrate an outstanding commitment to diversity and inclusion — the University of Maryland Graduate School will be featured, along with 113 other recipients, in the November/December 2024 issue of Insight Into Diversity magazine.

According to Georgina Dodge, the university's vice president for diversity and inclusion, "The Graduate School at the University of Maryland ensures that students receive the support needed to thrive, which positively impacts retention and recruitment. The diversity in the graduate student body creates a community where robust learning and cultural interactions can occur, and that synergy helps to attract diverse students to UMD."

Insight Into Diversity magazine selected the University of Maryland Graduate School for its outstanding dedication to building a diverse and inclusive student community. The university offers prospective students the chance to delve into the world of graduate studies and research careers. One of the ways it does this is by providing undergraduates with extensive research opportunities under the guidance of faculty mentors and engaging enrichment activities. For example, the Summer Research Opportunities Program (SROP) spans eight to ten weeks and is designed to equip undergraduates with the skills and mentorship necessary to excel in graduate school and research careers. This program aims to boost the participation of underrepresented students in pursuing graduate education and thriving in research-related professions.

UMD was also lauded for its intentional efforts to provide comprehensive training for faculty and staff involved in graduate admissions reviews. The UMD Graduate Holistic Review Program equips

admissions reviewers with the necessary tools to ensure that qualified students from diverse backgrounds are admitted, promoting inclusivity within the institution.

The University of Maryland Graduate School is dedicated to fostering a diverse and inclusive academic community by actively recruiting students from underrepresented backgrounds. They provide valuable opportunities for prospective students to explore graduate study and research careers. Additionally, the school prioritizes creating a supportive environment for all students. The GradSERU graduate student survey is utilized to analyze and identify areas for improvement, ensuring that the Graduate School continues to make special efforts to recruit a diverse student body and provide inclusive access. Furthermore, the Graduate School offers valuable support and resources to maintain a welcoming campus climate for all.

"The HEED Award process consists of a comprehensive and rigorous application that includes questions relating to the recruitment and retention of students and employees — and best practices for both — leadership support for diversity, campus culture and climate, supplier diversity, and many other aspects of campus diversity and inclusion," said Lenore Pearlstein, publisher of Insight Into Diversity magazine. "We take a detailed approach to reviewing each application in deciding who will be named a HEED Award recipient. Our standards are high, and we look for institutions where diversity and inclusion are woven into the work being done every day across their campus."
